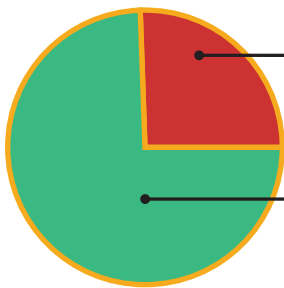
SHAPING THE FUTURE,

The goal of the Tokata Initiative is to fund the new Tokata Youth Center (TYC). This 7,500 square foot facility opened in September 2022. Already over 470 youth are enrolled and seeking to participate in programming! These Native American youths are among the most at-risk and under-resourced youth in our Nation. The TYC is meeting critical needs of the Crow Creek Sioux Reservation youth by providing a safe and stable environment modeling biblical principles and Dakota Oyate values. At the TYC, youth are receiving educational tutoring and life skills training from mentors who prioritize physical, emotional, mental, and spiritual health.

PROVISION: financial resources of cash and non-cash assets to reach the \$5.1 million goal.

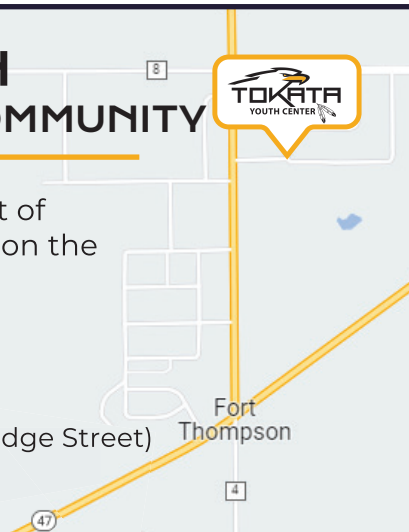

Located in the heart of Fort Thompson, SD on the Crow Creek Sioux Reservation.

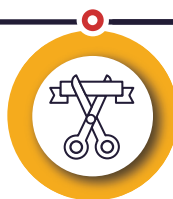
