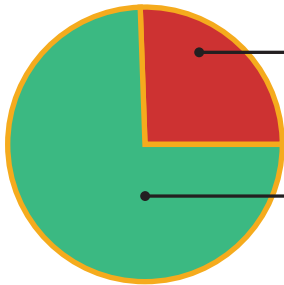
SHAPING THE FUTURE,

The goal of the Tokata Initiative is to fund the new Tokata Youth Center (TYC). This 7,500 square foot facility will greatly increase outreach from the 126 attending quarterly, to the nearly 400 youth who are seeking to participate in programming. The TYC's purpose is to meet critical needs of the Crow Creek Sioux Reservation youth by providing a stable environment that models biblical principles. At the TYC, youth will receive educational tutoring and life skills training from mentors who prioritize physical, emotional, mental, and spiritual health.

PROVISION: financial resources of cash and non-cash assets to reach the \$5.1 million goal.

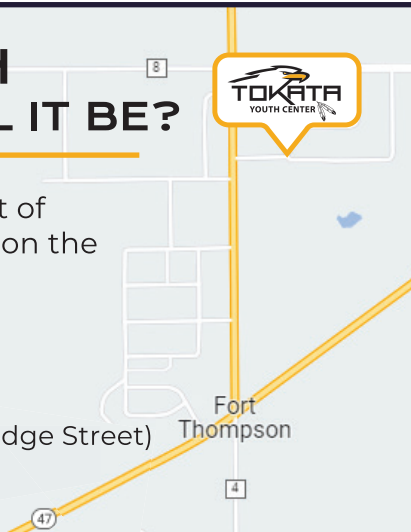

Located in the heart of Fort Thompson, SD on the Crow Creek Sioux Reservation.

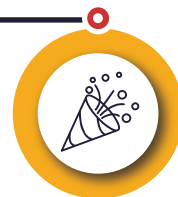
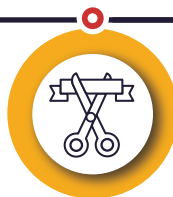
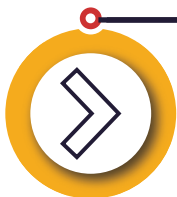
